ROTARACT CLUB

Rotaract originally began as a Rotary International youth program in 1968 at Charlotte North Rotary Club in Charlotte, North Carolina, United States, and has grown into a major Rotary-sponsored organization of over 9,522 clubs spread around the world and 291,006 members. It is a service, leadership, professional and community service organization (often miscommunicated as a Social Service Club) for young men and women between the ages 18–30.

Rotaract focuses on the development of young adults as leaders in their communities and workplaces. Clubs around the world also take part in international service projects, in a global effort to bring peace and international understanding to the world.

“Rotaract” stands for “Rotary in Action”, although the name originally comes from a combination of “Rotary” and “Interact” (International + Action), the high school level program created by Rotary International in 1962.

Most Rotaract activities take place at the club level. Rotaract clubs hold formal meetings, usually every two weeks, which feature speakers, special outings, social activities, discussions or visits to other clubs. Club members get together on designated days for service project work, social events, or professional/leadership development workshops.

The purpose of Rotaract is to provide an opportunity for young men and women to enhance the knowledge and skills that will assist them in personal development, to address the physical and social needs of their communities, and to promote better relations between all people worldwide through a framework of friendship and service. To be eligible for membership, prospective members must be 18–30 years of age, show that they are committed to Rotaract, and show that they are of good standing in the community. After being approved by the club, prospective members are ‘inducted’ to become members, also known as ‘Rotaractors’.

4. Online sessions and awareness program for High School Students

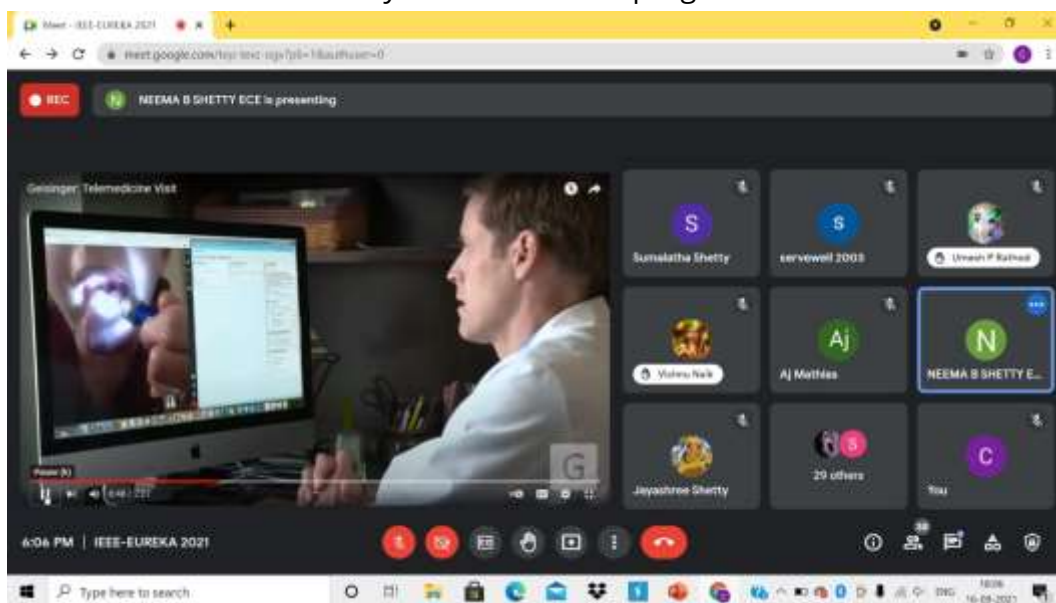

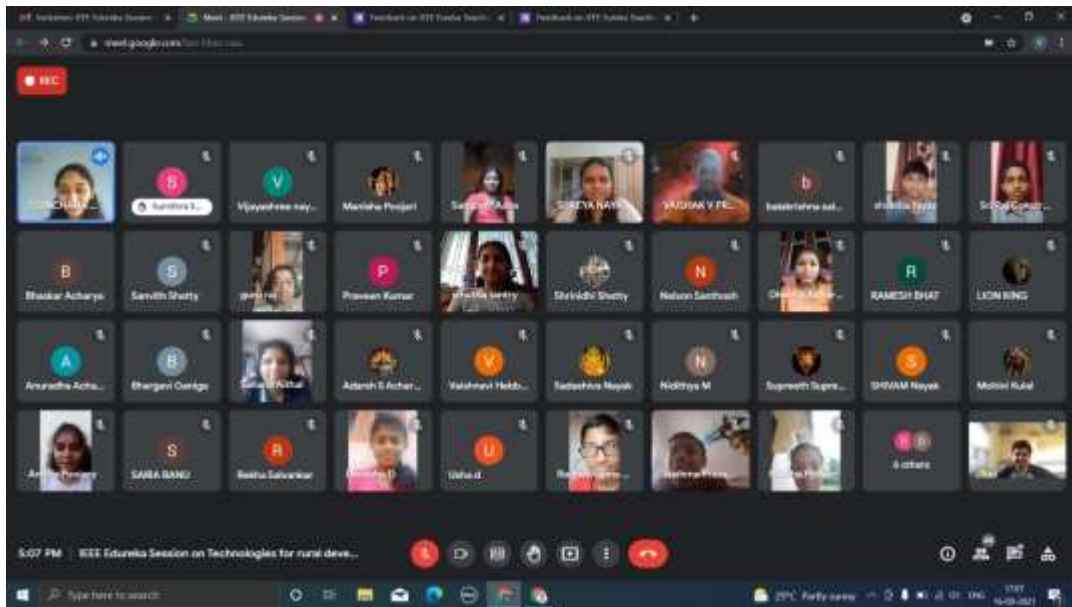
The major objectives of the event are:

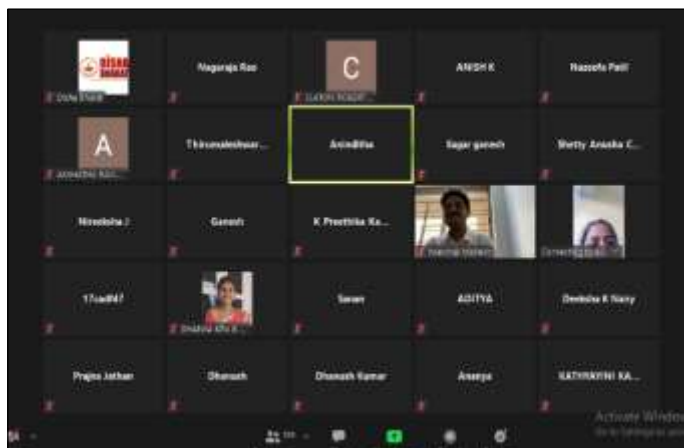


18. Webinar on “Netaji’s Parakram-An Inspiration to Youth” on the occasion of Parakram Diwas and Republic Day

He said that the E-Shram portal was launched by the Ministry of Labour and employment under the Government of India to form a database of unorganized workers including construction workers, migrant workers, gig workers, platform workers, street vendors, domestic workers, agriculture workers etc. He also mentioned that workers across segments can register themselves on the new portal with the help of their Aadhar number and Bank account details etc.

He mentioned that E-Shram portal is seeded with Aadhar will be used to deliver all the social security benefits of the Central and State Governments for the unorganized workers. All eligible registered workers between the ages 16 to 59 can register on the E-Shram portal and gets an Accidental Insurance cover of 2 Lacs under PMSBY from the date of issue of policy. Under E-Shram portal, the occupation of the worker is being captured to provide identity to the workers with their occupations. It will facilitate governments to devise social security welfare to all the segments of the unorganized workers. There are 30 broad sector categories activities and 190 broad families of occupations around 400 occupations it had added. The people under organized sector who is a member of ESIC or EPFO or a person who is paying income tax are not eligible to register for E-Shram card.
