RULES AND REGULATIONS

Science Model Competition

- > Colleges may send maximum of **two teams** for this event
- > Team may comprise of maximum of **four members**.
- ➤ Water, electricity facility will be provided for every team members (Please mention these requirements and also if any additional facility needed, in the registration form itself.)
- > Only working models are allowed for competition
- ➤ Participants may prepare chart for explaining the working of the model, if needed.

Science and Technology Quiz

- ➤ Colleges may send maximum of **two teams** for this event
- > Team may comprise of maximum of **three members**
- ➤ All questions are based on science and technology
- ➤ If there are many teams for this event, there will be prelims to shortlist top-6 teams for the final round

Scientific Concept based poster design

- Colleges may send maximum of **two teams** for this event
- > Team may comprise of maximum of **two members**
- ➤ A3 size sheet will be provided for all teams and teams are required to design the poster during the event on a chosen topic from the list of topics given by the organizers
- List of topics on which poster to be designed will be displayed in the college website (www.sode-edu.in) three days prior to the event
- > Any type of color may be used for poster
- > Duration for poster design is **three hours**.

General instructions:

- ❖ All participating students would get participation certificates
- ❖ Top three teams of Model exhibition event will be given with certificate of merit for every team member along with cash prize of Rs 5,000, Rs,3000 and Rs. 2,000 respectively.
- Top three teams of Quiz and poster design events will be given with certificate of merit for every team member along with cash prize of Rs 2,000, Rs,1,000 and Rs. 750 respectively.
- ❖ Championship is calculated based on the points gained by each participating team as follows. First Prize − 50 points, Second Prize − 30 points and Third Prize − 20 points. Any college who earns maximum points will be awarded with championship trophy and second highest point winning college will be conferred with runners up trophy.
