ROTARACT CLUB

Rotaract originally began as a Rotary International youth program in 1968 at Charlotte North Rotary Club in Charlotte, North Carolina, United States, and has grown into a major Rotary-sponsored organization of over 9,522 clubs spread around the world and 291,006 members. It is a service, leadership, professional and community service organization (often miscommunicated as a Social Service Club) for young men and women between the ages 18–30.

Rotaract focuses on the development of young adults as leaders in their communities and workplaces. Clubs around the world also take part in international service projects, in a global effort to bring peace and international understanding to the world.

“Rotaract” stands for “Rotary in Action”, although the name originally comes from a combination of “Rotary” and “Interact” (International + Action), the high school level program created by Rotary International in 1962.

Most Rotaract activities take place at the club level. Rotaract clubs hold formal meetings, usually every two weeks, which feature speakers, special outings, social activities, discussions or visits to other clubs. Club members get together on designated days for service project work, social events, or professional/leadership development workshops.

The purpose of Rotaract is to provide an opportunity for young men and women to enhance the knowledge and skills that will assist them in personal development, to address the physical and social needs of their communities, and to promote better relations between all people worldwide through a framework of friendship and service. To be eligible for membership, prospective members must be 18–30 years of age, show that they are committed to Rotaract, and show that they are of good standing in the community. After being approved by the club, prospective members are ‘inducted’ to become members, also known as ‘Rotaractors’.

STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURE

Procedure to formulate the NSS unit in SMVITM:

• Rules, regulations and policies shall be formulated by the highest authority of the institution (The Management of the institution) and shall be put up to the Governing Council Members. Suggestions shall be incorporated by amending them.

• A suitable person (who must be faculty of SMVITM) shall be selected, who must in turn drive the NSS Unit ably in the right direction by abiding to the objectives and also to the management of the institution.

• Head of all departments shall select a suitable faculty from each department who must assist the overall coordinator of NSS and also to handle the departmental level assignments if any.

Formulation of the student chapter of NSS office bearers

• With the approval of the Principal and heads of all the departments the institutional coordinator for NSS shall form a student office bearer’s team who shall be competent enough to carry out the agenda of NSS for the academic year and along with that abide by the objectives and active involvement and participate in all the activities throughout the calendar year.

Selection of the president for NSS of the institutional student chapter

• NSS coordinator with consent from the head of all departments must select suitable candidate as the president for NSS student chapter who is competent enough to lead the team office bearers and student volunteers.

Accumulation of student volunteers for NSS

• Overall coordinator along with the departmental coordinators shall be responsible to spread the spirit and message of NSS and gather large number of student volunteers for team NSS.

• A nominal registration fee of Rs. 100 shall be collected from each member which shall be later used for all the related activities.

Formulation of the academic calendar (Blue Print) of activities of NSS

• The institutional coordinator with the assistance of the departmental coordinator shall formulate the blue print of all the activities (with social

impact) for the academic year and an efficient action plan shall be Planned in-order to execute the said activities.

Conduction of NSS meetings

- At least one meeting in a semester will be conducted with involvement of Overall Coordinator, Departmental Coordinator and all office bearers of the committee. Minutes of meeting will be prepared for the same.

Conduction of NSS activities

- Informal meetings shall be conducted before execution of any event.
- With Consent of Principal and HODs of all departments the final plan shall be approved.
- Event shall be conducted with identified and reputed resource persons from outside.
- NSS Camps shall be conducted once in every year.
- An event file along with the report and photographs shall be submitted to the authority after the completion of every event.

Attendance list of students attending programs:

- Office bearers are given the task of preparing list of students who attended the activity/Program under NSS.
- List of students who attended the program will be prepared by the office bearers and same will be forwarded to the Overall coordinator.
- Overall coordinator will merge all that information and will prepare single list which indicates all attendees and will attest the same.
- Particular attendance list will be send to all department HOD's for further requirements.

Representing annual VTU Programme Officer's meeting:

- Institutional coordinator for NSS shall be the representative of annual meeting of VTU POs which is mostly held in Bengaluru. The developments, grievances of POs shall be discussed in the annual meeting.
- Decisions taken in the meeting shall be implemented in the institution with suitable fine tuning.

General Plan of Action for conduction and execution of any event:

- Planning all the events for the academic year in consent with the IQAC
- Conduction of regular meetings and assigning roles and responsibilities to the committee members.
- Selecting the resource person for the respective events.
- Inviting them as per the protocol.
- Looking after the arrangements
- Conduction and execution of the events
- Conducting concluding meeting and reviving the event
- Submission of the reports to the IQAC
- Plan for the next event.

Conduction of Camps:

- Seeking the financial grant from the affiliated university.
- Preparing the best plan so as to the maximum utilization of the sanctioned amount.

Reforming the NSS team:

- After each academic year NSS student chapter shall be dissolved after the annual day meeting and shall be reformed in the next academic year.

Reforming of objectives, Roles and Responsibility:

- At any point of time the objective, Roles and Responsibility may be changed based on the requirement.

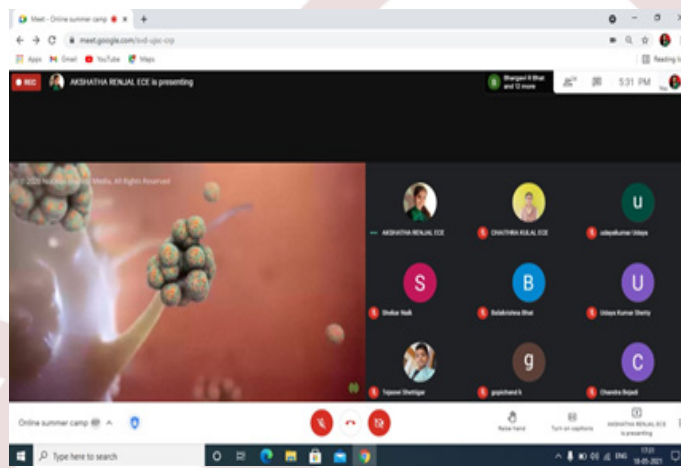
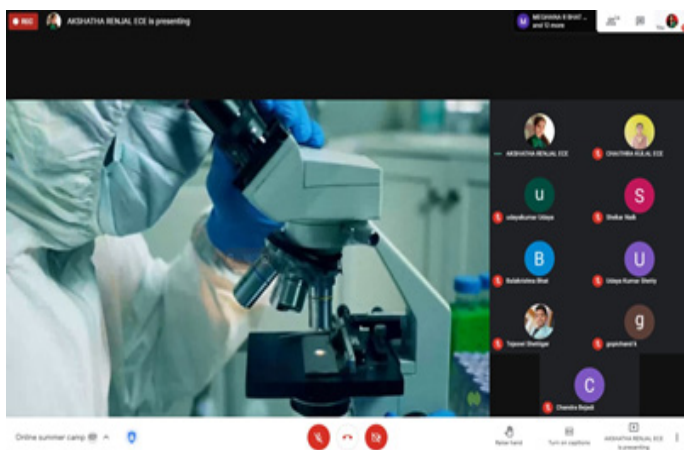
Online Summer Camp

Dr. Manoj Kumar Sharma started his presentation based on this year’s theme “Commit to Quit” and said that the aim of this day is to spread awareness about the dangers of using tobacco, to make tobacco users aware of the opportunity to lead a healthier life and how health problems can be tackled by doctors when one quits smoking. He explained various types of tobacco consumption and its effects, ingredients in a puff of smoke and said, smokers are more likely to have heart disease, stroke, cancer, chronic lung disease and diabetes, all of which are important comorbidities for developing severe illness and adversely affecting the clinical outcome in COVID affected patients. He also gave some tips and guidelines to quit tobacco like (i) make a ‘quit plan’ and stick to it (ii) avoid stressful situations (iii) 5-min walk or stretch (iv) Nicotine-replacement therapy like chewing gum or skin-patches etc.

Dr. Thirumaleshwara Bhat, Principal; Dr. Ganesh Aithal, Vice Principal; Deans, HODs of various departments were present during the occasion. Mr. Nagaraja Rao, Coordinator NSS and Ms. Shashikala, Coordinator Counselling Cell, conducted the program. 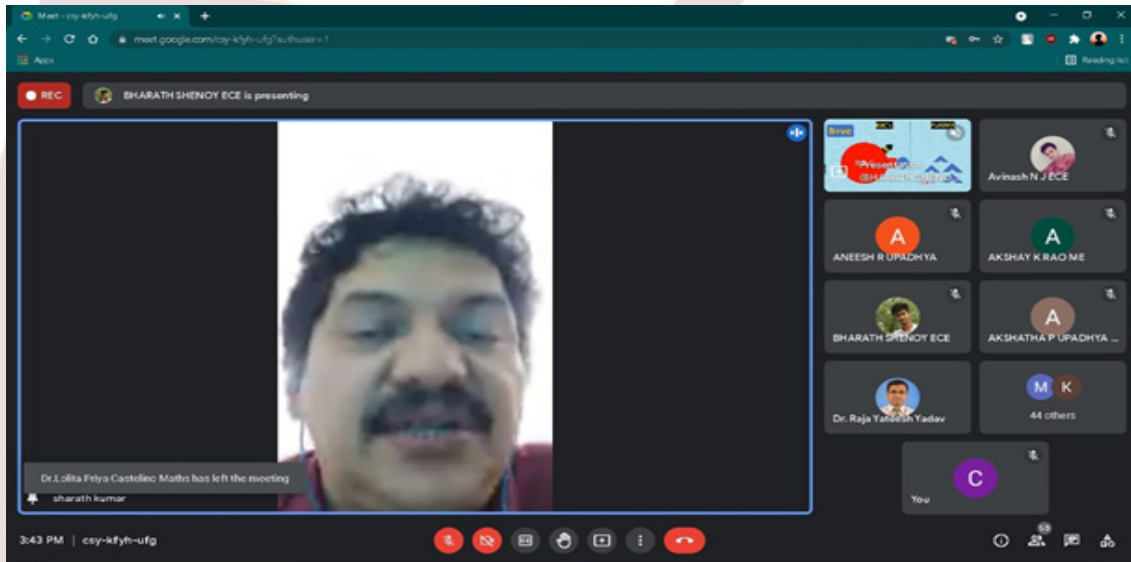


Celebration of World Blood Donor Day

The Youth Red Cross (YRC) Wing in association with NSS Unit of Shri Madhwa Vadiraja Institute of Technology and Management, Bantakal celebrated the “World blood Donor Day-2021” on 14 June 2021 which was held virtually called “stay tuned stay safe”. Dr. Sharath Kumar Rao J, senior consultant and HOD Department of Immunohematology and Transfusion medicine, a regional Blood Transfusion centre at Wenlock District Hospital, Mangalore, was the resource person of this session. Dr. Sharath Kumar gave information about Blood donation

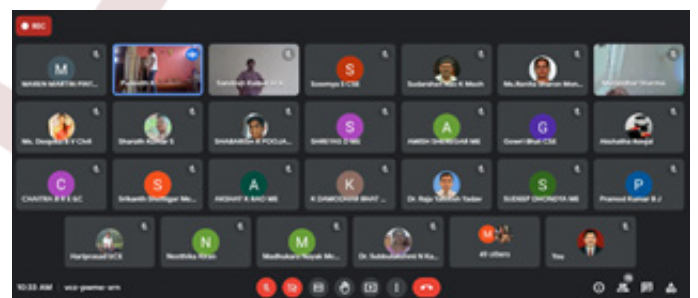
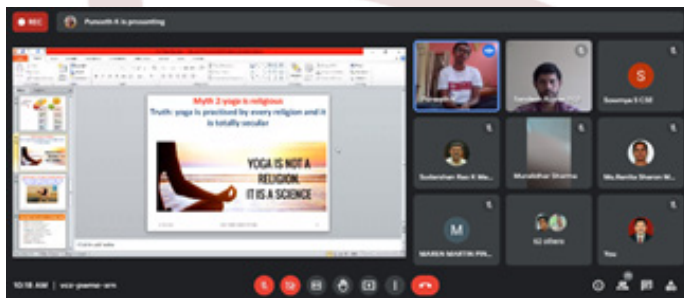
and also quoted that “THE LIFE OF THE FLESH IS IN THE BLOOD”. He mentioned that the minimum age for donating blood is from 18-65 years and people weighing below 45kg are not supposed to donate blood. Men can donate blood 150 times in his lifetime whereas women can donate blood thrice in a year which means once in a 4month. Speaker also gave a brief idea about a different type of Antigens and Antibodies present in blood cells and gave a piece of information about different types of blood leaving a common A, B, O blood group. He also mentioned different types of transfusion like

Plasma transfer; Platelets Transfer, Stem Cell transfer and he said that these are also some of the important transfusions. He had answered some of the queries with respect to blood donation and blood transfusion methods and answered some of the queries with respect to vaccination like why should a person shouldn't donate blood after his vaccination and he also said why the plasma transfusion was done for the covid positive patient by taking plasma from the recovered covid patient. The session was very interactive gained a piece of knowledge about blood donation and blood transfusion. More than 90 students including Deans, HOD's, teaching and non-teaching staff members of various departments were participated in the webinar. The program was compeered by Mr. Bharath Shenoy of 8th Sem ECE dept and Mr. Akshay Rao of 6th sem Mechanical dept introduced resource person (Speaker) followed by a vote of thanks proposed by Mr. Chiranth of 4th sem Computer Science & Engineering.
