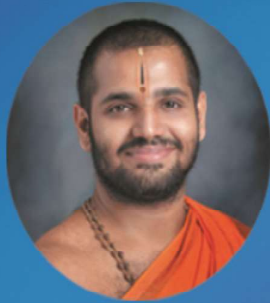

Dr. N S Sriram, Professor, Mechanical Engineering department, VVIET, Mysore and Dr. K R Prakash, Professor, Mechanical Engineering department, NIE, Mysore were the resource persons. The training program includes introduction to hydraulics, hydraulic pumps, motors, cylinders, control valves, circuit designing and building, study of proportional valves, hydraulic fluids and filtration, and also hands on session on construction and operation of hydraulic assemblies on the training rig. The training program also includes introduction to Pneumatics, Fundamentals of Pneumatics, Basic components - Cylinders and Valves, their working and interactions, electro pneumatic circuit diagram, and also hands on session on building pneumatic circuits on the training rig. Mr. Ganesh Kalagi and Mr. Manjunath S, Senior Assistant Professors of Mechanical Engineering department have coordinated this training program.

Mr. Javins mainly focused on the selection processes involved in Infosys. Speaker shared about the different rounds of selection and guided the students how best one could prepare for the same. Topics from which questions would appear in the aptitude test was told clearly and asked the students to focus on those topics so as to clear the first round. Being from Mechanical Engineering stream, exposure that IT field provides was also mentioned by the speaker and encouraged the students to apply for IT jobs and excel in the same. Speaker shared his own experience that he had faced during his job interviews and gave insights on how one should appear before the interview panelists by stressing on conduct, dress code, body language, self-confidence etc., and thereby stating its importance in fetching a job. Also the students are made to speak during the session as a part of demo on HR interviews. Together with how to crack interviews for Infosys, Mr. Javins also provided tips to clear Indian Army and Air force exams.

Mr. Karthik S Kateel demonstrated techniques on how women can defend herself when attacked by a stranger or group of people by making them aware about sensitive parts in human body and provided them tips through simple techniques to get dangerous situation under their control. He also suggested students not to be panic, angry, confused, run away or make the attacker angrier and not to kick or punch, instead one has to be smarter and understand the mindset of the attacker in order to select their move. He also advised students to take precautions and avoid becoming victims of kidnaps, assaults and dangerous situations. His mother, Mrs. Shobhalatha assisted him in various demonstrations related to self-defense technique. The EDC cell had organized an industrial visit to Chaamundeshwari Stone crusher unit at Hampankatta Phalli and Stone cutting unit at Karkala on 17<sup>th</sup> September 2019. The trip was organized for second year students of Civil engineering department. In the first trip students have visited aggregate manufacturing unit, they have learnt how quarrying process will takes place, starting from blasting, precautionary measures before blasting and detonators used for blasting purposes. Later they were taken to the control unit of the crusher and conveyor belt and its working sequence. Students have also learnt how the primary and secondary crushing unit works for the manufacture of various sizes of aggregates.

Detailed operation of M-Sand manufacturing unit was demonstrated by the proprietor Mr. Chandrashekar Shetty and interacted with the students

Second visit was to Mahalingeshwara stone works at karkala, where students have witnessed various types of stone cutting machines and different types of stone surface finish and carvings. Total 29 students from second year civil engineering students have benefited from this excursion.
