

1. Prelude

Outcome Based Education (OBE) is a student-centric teaching and learning methodology with assessment of Course Outcomes (COs) as the key factor. Course delivery, assessments are planned to achieve the stated objectives and outcomes. In this regard, initially each course is defined with its course outcomes and are mapped to the respective Program Outcomes (POs) and Program Specific Outcomes (PSOs). Each unit of the course shall be organized with Topic Level Outcomes (TLOs) which are mapped with the relevant COs. At the end of the course, CO has to be assessed and evaluated through TLOs using different assessment tools. The level of attainment reflects the standard of accomplishment of the desired goal.



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
