Industrial Visit to Varahi Hydel Project, KPCL, Hosangadi

The Department of Mechanical Engineering, in association with Entrepreneurship Development Cell and ISTE student chapter of the institute has organized an industrial visit to Varahi Hydel Project, KPCL, Hosangadi on 29 September 2023 for the benefit of final year students of Mechanical Engineering.

Industrial visit helps to combine theoretical knowledge with practical knowledge. In this concern, Department of Mechanical Engineering, under the banner of Entrepreneurship Development Cell and ISTE Student Chapter has organized this visit.

The Varahi underground powerhouse has two stages with four generating units and is an engineering marvel as it is an underground powerhouse built by excavating a huge rock. A huge cave with a width of 20 metres and height of 30 metres is built for a length of 155 metres to house generation units and related components nearly 78 metres below the ground level. In addition to this, nearly a km-long access tunnel has been excavated. Power plant consists of 4 High Head Pelton Turbines and



the capacity per turbine is 115 MW (4 Units x 115MW = 460 MW).

Dr. Bharath K Bhat Asst. Professor (Selection Grade) and Mr. Karthik V, Asst. Professor (Sr.) in the Department of Mechanical Engineering have accompanied the students.

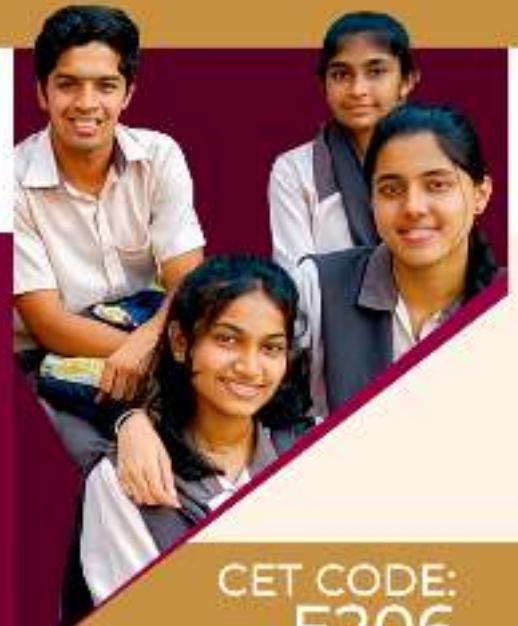
