

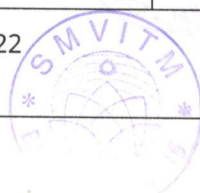



Therefore focus the publicity/admission campaign restricted to Udupi and nearby districts.</p> <p>Proper orientation to the students about the new courses is the need of the hour. Hence guide the students in advance on the selection of the courses. Also conduct webinar from industry experts on the requirements of the industry.</p> <p>The management has decided to continue the reservation policy adopted during 2018-19 and scholarship for the deserving students. Also the management approved increase in the number of scholarships by allocating a budgetary support of Rs. 05 Lakhs during 2020-21.</p> <p>Information about starting B.Sc course by the VTU from the AY 2021-22 is placed before the honorable members.
